The Miss Colleen represents the Irish Congress of Southern California (ICSC) at the Parade and Festival as well as at other ICSC and Irish community events.

The Contest consists of off-stage interviews with the judges, followed by an on-stage introduction to the local community where the contestant will answer several questions. The event will be open to family and friends to attend in support.

No application fee is required. Instead, each contestant will be sponsored by a local business for \$175.00.
